Technical Chair Report- Julie Morgan Orlinsky

Julie updated the group on judging rule changes.

- 1) Cat 3 courses will not be a hybrid, the practical will be online, the practicum will still be in person, and this will expedite the process.
- 2) No competition cards will be needed level 8 and below
- 3) Comp cards 9 and up can be given at the assigned spot OR at the judges table. No competition card will result in a do not start, athlete cannot compete without a card.
- 4) Shorts can be solid color that matches the leotard, or solid black
- 5) Piercings will be accepted if they are taped, the piercing cannot be visible, and must be covered with tape. It is noted that the judge prefers you take them out, but they will now be allowed to compete with them as long as they are taped. Lack of tape and proper coverage will result in a do not start
- 6) NEW PROPOSAL: Since we are short on judges and the issue is not getting any better a proposal is made that each gym must provide one judge. This judge cannot judge and coach at the same meet, so if they are coaching every meet, or competing at every met, they would not be able to qualify as a judge. Inability to provide a judge will result in a \$100 penalty per Illinois competition from the gym. This idea was tabled, and a committee was set up to discuss possible options.

Committee formed to discuss how to get more judges. Chairman Megan Gearhat, Lacey Jenkins, Julie Morgan-Orlinsky, Carrie Shaw and Guy Merker

New Business

We are looking to host a clinic, Had a date in November but this date will not work—Change to potential date first of December, we will need at least 15 participants to make the clinic viable.

Coaches Report- Mike VanSpankeren no new news other than concerns about the equipment, he recommended looking at other companies.

Laurie also addressed the equipment issues, encourages coaches and judges to check equipment frequently at meets to encourage proper set up.

New rules have been put in place for elite mobility which look to be in favor of athletes, judges and coaches, please research the changes to stay up to date.

USA Gymnastics Illinois

1. STATE BOARD:

2. Voting Procedure:

USA Gymnastics State By-Laws) all of the advisors on the USA Gymnastics Illinois State Advisory Board are allowed one vote only. Clubs are allowed one vote only. No person may have more than one vote. The state director has a non-voting position. If a matter needs to be voted on during the season, the state advisory board will be called upon to decide on the matter. Nonaffiliated professional member allowed one vote

3. Procedures At Meets:

Per USA Gymnastics requirements

A. Awards: Medals or its equivalent will be presented for places 1-10. State Championships are required to award the USA Gymnastics medal for 1st through 3rd places. The official supplier for USA Gymnastics awards is A-1 in Indianapolis, IN...# (800) 444-9569.

B. Meet Results: Copies of meet results must be given to teams by the host club at any sanctioned meet. A complete copy must

be sent to the State Director for each sanctioned meet in Illinois or co-sanctioned meet by Illinois...

4. Fees:

- a. Illinois Judge's Fee:** Each club attending a meet is encouraged to supply a judge for the meet. It should be noted that judges will be compensated at a rate of .45 per mile for travel. Judges who travel over 90 miles will also get \$60.00 toward hotel room

- b. Illinois State Club Fees:** All USA Gymnastics Illinois teams will pay a \$50.00 fee to the USA Gymnastics Illinois State Treasurer by December 31, 2023. This fee will be \$75.00 after January 1, 2024 for all current clubs. This late fee will not be applicable to new clubs joining USA Gymnastics after January 1, 2024.

- c. Illinois Athlete's Fee:** At all Illinois sanctioned meets, the host club will pay a fee of \$1.00 per athlete attending the meet to the Illinois USA Gymnastics State Fund. Please make these payments to the USA Gymnastics Illinois State Fund. Please mail these payments to the Illinois State Director.

5. Coaches:

- A. Pay a minimum of 50% of approved hotel to judges traveling over 100 miles one way to the meet.

Elite Committees Meeting Agenda

1. Welcome

All attendees were asked to disclose any actual or potential conflicts of interest based on a review of the agenda.

- It was agreed that all committee members have conflicts of interest as a result of being athletes, coaches, judges and/or club owners and/or receiving compensation at times from the T&T program. Except in the case of any items bulleted below, the individuals and committee share the view that members are able to act impartially and for the benefit of the program, and recusal is not necessitated for any other items.

2. Code of Points

2.1. Saluting for Qualification

It was clarified that the Elite program reverts to FIG rules unless there is an exception listed in the U.S. CoP – in this case there is not. Therefore, it is not permitted to qualify to Finals without performing a pass. Per FIG:

- *"Did not start" ("DNS") indicates that the athlete did not perform a routine, or did not receive any score or any value(s) for the elements attempted.*
- *"DNS" only, without a score, will result in no ranking.*

2.2. Spotting Positions

Recommend that the Development Committee considers changing the Development CoP to allow coaches to spot on either side of the apparatus during competition, to match the FIG Code of Points.

2.3. Finals Format

The Committee discussed whether cumulative or new life finals should be used in the new quad. It was agreed at this time that all Elite levels should be kept as new life, however the final decision will be taken during the new quad CoP development process.

2.4. Tie Breakers

It was noted that the PC determined that the Elite CoP General 7.5.1 incorrectly states that *Ties in the finals will not be broken*, and that the CoP should be updated to reference the FIG Technical Regulations.

It was agreed that the specific FIG tie breakers to be applied should be the World Championship ones.

3. R&P

With the mobility window being extended, it was agreed that athletes should be able to mobilize into the division of their current age, rather than their age for the next competition season.

Motion to allow athletes to mobilize into the division of their current age (i.e., age as at December 31 of the year at the closing date of the mobility window).

1. Welcome

All attendees were asked to disclose any actual or potential conflicts of interest based on a review of the agenda.

It was agreed that all committee members have conflicts of interest as a result of being athletes, coaches, judges and/or club owners and/or receiving compensation at times from the T&T program. The individuals and committee share the view that members are able to act impartially and for the benefit of the program, and recusal is not necessitated for any other items.

2. Piercings

The Committee noted the rule put forward by the Technical Committee, being:

"All piercings should be removed; alternatively, if piercings are not removed they must be completely covered. If outside of the leotard, the covering must be tape affixed to the body, and be tan, black or white. The penalty for breaking this rule should be 0.2 taken from the total score of each routine it occurs in. Jewelry larger than a simple stud earring would constitute a major violation and the athlete would not be allowed to start."

3. Competition Cards

"Depending on the level of the competition, a designated time and place may be set in the competition directives as a deadline for competition cards. Any competition cards not turned in by the designated time and place will need to be submitted to the judging panel at the start of each athlete's specific flight of competition. Additional competition cards should be available at each judging panel for any athletes or coaches to complete if needed. Athletes at Levels 9+ will not be permitted to compete until the competition card has been received by the judging panel for that event."

4. Spotting Positions

5. Open 17-21

The committee further discussed a proposal to rename Open 17-21 for the new Quad. The committee will continue to discuss pros and cons of this option. It was agreed that additional education around Open should be included in the T210, and colors be added to the [mobility structure](#) on the website.

6. New Quad Routines

Nuno and Jacqui are working on a feedback form for the current quad routines, to be sent out to the community. Additional questions about the Development program will be added to this feedback form – the Committee was asked to submit question suggestions to Nuno. Feedback will be used when starting work on the new quad routines.

7. Regional Champions Qualification to Nationals

Qualification as a Regional Champion will not be achieved under the following circumstances:

- *The first-place athlete is a resident of a different region who was granted participation in a regional championship outside of their own.*

8. Splitting Levels with Large Numbers

In previous quads it was possible able to split levels with high numbers. In the current quad, the rule does not allow this at the National level. The committee discussed pros and cons for this for the new quad. It was generally felt that levels should not be split, and the item was tabled.

9. National Qualification Scores

The committee looked at the numbers attending Gym Champs. In 2023 there were over 950 athletes, vs 850 two years ago. The schedule is currently over maximum capacity and the committee was asked to look at options to pull back towards 850 total athletes. It was agreed that in the short term, this is best achieved through raising qualification scores.

It was noted that Stars & Stripes has room to grow, and this is an area that the committee would like to continue to encourage greater participation.

4. Spotting Positions

The committee considered a recommendation from the Development Committee to allow coaches to spot on either side of Double Mini and Tumbling during competition (Trampoline has no restriction on where coaches can stand):

- *“Coaches are allowed to spot, or stand with the intention to spot, from either side of the landing area for Double Mini. If the coach wishes to have a throw mat, this must be done from the opposite side to the judges.”*
