- Entry Process:** Registration for the 2026 Windy City Invitational Trampoline & Tumbling competition begins **Tuesday, September 2nd, 2025 at noon (CST)**. All entries must be done using the USAG meet reservation system. Click [HERE](#) to access meet entry instructions
- Entry Fee:** \$125 flat entry fee for one or all four events.

Entry fee includes **free t-shirt** and **free admission** to the men's & women's artistic gymnastics college competitions for each registered athlete. Be sure to e-mail gymnast t-shirt sizes to registration@windycitygymnastics.com.
- Entry Deadline:** All online entries and payments must be completed and submitted no later than **Monday, November 24th, 2025**. Entries postmarked or submitted after this date will incur a **\$5.00 late fee per gymnast**.

- Awards:** Awards will take place immediately following each flight's competition.
- Tentative Schedule:** Athletes will be taken to a specified awards area for the presentation of awards.
Saturday, January 17, 2026: Level 8 – Senior Elite training and competition
Saturday, January 17 and Sunday, January 18, 2025: Levels 1 – 7 competition.
Once entries are received, team sheets will be provided that will give specific times for all athletes.
- Competition Format:** The competition will consist of Level 1- Sr Elite.
The competition may be used for Level 8-10 mobility and eligibility for all levels.
Once athletes have completed their competition, they are free to leave.
- Qualification:** All athletes who have a current USA Gymnastics athlete membership are eligible to compete. All coaches must have a current Competitive Coach membership and have completed the 2025-2026 Annual T210 Program update prior to registration. All judges must have a current Judges membership and 2025-2026 and all Category 1 and FIG must have the T210 Annual updated to be considered for an assignment.
- Staging:** A stretching/staging area will be provided. Please DO NOT send your athletes to the staging area until 30 minutes prior to their scheduled time or until the flight has been called over the PA system. Everyone in staging and on the field of play must have a valid membership. Parents will not be allowed in the staging area.
- Results:** Results will be available using ScorSync. An onsite QR code will be made available for easy access. Results will be posted on site and a complete set of results will be sent to coaches at the completion of the competition.
- Apparel:** Apparel per the USAG Code of points must be followed for athletes and coaches. Awards apparel will be competition apparel or a full team sponsored warm up.
- Jewelry:** All piercings should be removed; alternatively, if piercings or permanent jewelry are not removed they must be completely covered. If outside of the leotard, the covering must be tape affixed to the body, and be tan, black or white. Untaped or uncovered piercings would constitute a major violation, and the athlete would not be allowed to start. All tape/covering must be tan, black or white.
- Scoring:** Pro Score will be the official scoring program. The total E score option that will be used to calculate each competitor's valid score. See the 2025-2029 Code of Points for official scoring and tie breaking information.
- Coaches Party:** Saturday, January 17th at Margaritaville on Navy Pier (immediately following the men's college competition)
