Registrations made or postmarked after this date will incur a \$10 charge per athlete until February 10th, \$25 per athlete from February 11 until March 16th. No adds after March 16th.
Changes:	Level Changes will be \$5 after February 2nd, after March 9th they will be \$10, No changes will be permitted after March 16th.

Awards: Awards will take place following each competitive group.

Tentative Schedule: Levels 8-Elite are expected to compete Saturday
Levels 1-7 are expected to compete Sunday

Competition Format Athletes level 1-Elite are eligible to compete at the USA Gymnastics Illinois State Championships. This is a qualifying and required event for both Stars and Stripes, as well as USA Gym Champs. Athletes and coaches must follow the national and state rules and policies regarding eligibility for this event.

All athletes and coaches with current USA gymnastics credentials are eligible to register for the state championships. All participants, coaches, and volunteers must be up to date on their USA Gymnastics membership requirements. Judges must have passed the 2025-2029 judges testing and will be paneled as the Illinois State Technical chair deems fit.

Staging: A warm up and staging area will be provided for the athletes. Athletes are expected to warm up no more than 30 minutes before their competition time.

Results: We will have a live scoring system, a QR code will be available to follow along with scores.
